Background

Swisscontact is inviting applications from development professionals for the position of Coordinator-Monitoring, Results Measurement (MRM) for BMMDP Phase II Project. The main objectives of the project are to develop a conducive policy environment for climate-sensitive microinsurance to stimulate climate-sensitive, client-centric, and commercially viable microinsurance products/services; to improve the support service market

through enhanced capacity of various support service actors (Public/Private Insurance companies, Technology Solution providers, etc); and to increase mass awareness and understanding of potential beneficiaries among lowincome households to encourage demand for climateresilient microinsurance products. This is mandated by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) and the second phase envisions fostering inclusive growth in the agriculture and livestock sector in Bangladesh through agriculture and livestock insurance along with riskreducing embedded extension services. Swisscontact is acting as the Managing Agent (MA) of the project and wants to have a better understanding of the microinsurance market with particular focus on agriculture and livestock and to come up with systemic interventions.

- Preparing other reports as per project requirements (i.e., enrolment monitoring/employment monitoring/trade specific monitoring report).
- Operationalizing the process of results-based financing within the project by analysing data collected through different monitoring activities.
- Facilitating integration and implementation of knowledge and content management through documenting best practices, innovative approaches, success stories and challenges across the project to promote learning and knowledge sharing from programme design and strategy development.
- Actively supporting Senior Managers towards development and implementation of strategy and framework for knowledge and content management and MRM.
